

Background

- West Kelowna continues to average 2% growth annually
 - There is only one secondary school on the Westside for nine elementary schools and two middle schools
- Enrolment at Mount Boucherie Secondary (MBSS) is at 112% capacity, projected to increase to 137% by 2030
- MBSS uses eleven portables with permission from the City for only two more
- Expansion of MBSS is unfeasable, inefficient, costly, and disruptive to learning

Create new spaces, suitable for 21st century learning



Eliminate the need for portable classrooms at MBSS, return playfield space to the school



Ability to create new childcare facilities for West Kelowna families and accommodate other community uses



Provide learning spaces to all families on the rapidly-growing Westside



Minimize capital costs and reduce maintenance, energy, and other operating costs
