2. COMMUNITY CEMETERY CLEAN-UP - OCTOBER 26:

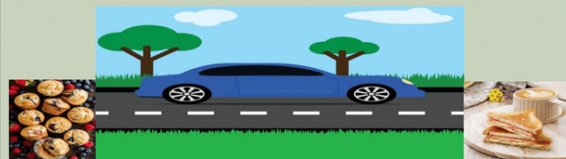
