Welcome back and thank you!

 It's going to be another great year ahead. Thanks from all of us for being involved in PAC, our school, and in your child's education. We are so very appreciative of parents/guardians who volunteer and make a difference.

Introductions

- O Darryl Smith (VP responsible for last names A-K)

• Start to the year, school population, growth, projections

- o It's been a very positive start to the school year. Our new students and staff are amazing and are settling in very well. I've been involved in multiple parent meetings this year already as we connect with families.
- We are up to approximately 875 students from last year's 830. The 12s we had leaving last year were considerably smaller than the Grade 8s coming in.
- Our grad class (sitting at 208 right now) is the largest grad class GESS has ever had

Parent/Guardian/Teacher Conference Open House (Oct 17, 5-7pm)

- Like last year, we have scheduled our first parent/guardian/teacher conference open house in mid-October. It is a more informal structure – teachers in classrooms, parents (and their child or children) with them walking through the school, connecting with staff, checking in.
- Like I shared in the Grade 9 parent info session, I strongly encourage parents/guardians to <u>not</u> wait for the open house to reach out to teachers if there is a need.

Cell Phone/Personal Device Mandate Update

- It has gone well so far. Teachers have noticed far fewer distractions in classes, and 99% of students have been great with the change.
- We appreciate our families' support with the new mandate.

- My hope would be that the PAC will be updating the online request form from last year, and I will let staff know. It was quick, convenient, and made it easy to collate data.
