**British Columbia 2024** 

Student Vote Canada is a learning program presented in collaboration with Elections Canada that provides students with the opportunity to experience the voting process firsthand and to practice the habits of active and informed citizenship.

Nearly 180,000 votes were reported from 1,034 schools, with results from all 93 electoral districts. 15 schools in the Kelowna-Lake Country-Coldstream electoral district took part in the voting process, including 221 of our George Elliot students from various Social Studies classes.

Results indicated that 55% of our students voted for the Conservative Party and 22% for the BC NDP.
